Later, happily, John Gilbert and Michel Labrecque agreed to talk on The Search for Two Lost Meteorological Artifacts (see abstract at: http://cmos.ca/site/ottawa).

Elections: for the 2018-2019 season, all current Members including the two Student Representatives are willing to stay on the Executive. With the approval of the Membership, Ann McMillan will be added to the list of Members-at-Large, Martin Gauthier will become Past Chair and Dawn Conway will be the Chair. The position of Vice Chair will be vacant. A shortlist of new Members was discussed to join the Executive, and to serve as Vice Chair. ACTIONS: Ann McMillan will seek to identify a new Member who will stand for the Vice Chair position; and will write up the new slate and print copies for Members to consider for the election of the Executive at the May meeting.

Membership: A strategy is needed to attract and retain Members, and for Corporate membership. Michael Steeves is working on the latter, and it is expected that the draft will be ready for discussion at the May meeting. **ACTION**: Michael will send out the draft prior to the May meeting.
